### **College Course Requirements**

There are now college-level course requirements for the certified classifications.

**Certified Residential:** Associates degree or higher in any field of study. In lieu of the required degree, twenty-one (21) semester credit hours covering the following subject matter courses: English Composition; Principles of Economics (Micro or Macro); Finance; Algebra, Geometry or, higher mathematics; Statistics; Introduction to Computers: Word Processing/ Spreadsheets; and Business or Real Estate Law.

**Certified General:** Bachelors degree or higher; in any field of study. In lieu of the required degree, thirty (30) semester credit hours covering the following subject matter courses: English Composition; Principles of Economics (Micro and Macro); Finance; Algebra, Geometry or higher mathematics; Statistics; Introduction to Computers: Word Processing/ Spreadsheets; Business or Real Estate Law; and two (2) elective courses in accounting, geography, agricultural economics, business management, or real estate.
