



FREE QUARTERLY FAIR HOUSING SEMINARS

This **three-hour course** teaches you about legal rights and responsibilities under the Fair Housing Law.

The course, offered by the Virginia Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation, gives you the basic foundation of Fair Housing Law required of all housing providers. **Ignorance of the law is not a defense!**

Who should take the class? Landlords, property managers, leasing consultants, owners of manufactured housing, real estate agents and brokers, the general public . . . anyone who sells, leases, owns, or manages residential property. Housing providers who complete the course are eligible for state certification by the Fair Housing Board.

Classes are FREE but registration is required.
