# Deadline Approaching for Onsite Sewage System Professionals

## *Interim license applications due by June 30<sup>th</sup>*

Effective July 1, 2009, Virginia law requires that **soil evaluators, installers, and operators** of onsite sewage systems must be licensed by the Board for Waterworks and Wastewater Works Operators and Onsite Sewage System Professionals at the Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation (DPOR).

To facilitate the transition of those individuals currently practicing as installers or operators, an interim license is available from DPOR. Interim installer and operator license applications must be received at DPOR no later than **June 30, 2010**.

*Applicants who fail to meet the deadline above must meet all relevant entry requirements, including passing the Board-approved examination.*
