

Signs and Symptoms of Formaldehyde exposure

- Exposure can be from breathing it, getting it on your skin, in your eyes or mouth
- Is a known cancer-causing substance
- Can cause eye irritation, damage including blindness
- Nose irritation
- Rashes, itching, breathing diffi-
