CHILD SUPPORT WITHHOLDING DISCLOSURE FORM

(for classified and wage employees)

The code of Virginia (Section 60.2-114), as amended by Chapter 165 of the 1993 Acts of Assembly, requires employers to request newly hired employees to disclose whether they have an income withholding order for child support. If the employee is subject to required withholding, the employer must begin withholding according to the terms of the order.

Accordingly as a condition of becoming employed by the Virginia Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation (DPOR), new employees are required to complete the following information and sign the form.

This information will not be divulged except as authorized by law.

Any person who willfully violates the provisions of Title 60.2 of the Code of Virginia is guilty of a Class I misdemeanor, as prescribed by section 60.2-121.
